

*** PUBLIC INFORMATION BULLETIN***

On June 11th, 2021 at 2:14am, the Lindsay Department of Public Safety received a call of a commercial structure fire at Cumbias Accessories, 122 E. Honolulu, Lindsay, CA. Personnel quickly responded to the scene, with the first unit arriving at 2:16am. Upon their arrival, they observed the building was full of fire and smoke. Mutual-Aid was requested, and personnel commenced with fire suppression operations. The City of Lindsay would like to express their gratitude to the Tulare County Fire Department, Porterville Fire Department, Tulare Fire Department, and Visalia Fire Department who dispatched fire apparatus and personnel to assist. The fire was found to have spread to nearby businesses within the same structure, damaging four businesses. Fortunately, no individuals were hurt.

As of the time of the release of this public information bulletin, crews are still conducting fire operations and the area around the business has been closed. The public is asked to stay away from the area. The Friday Night Market has been cancelled until further notice.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation. Anyone with further information regarding this incident is urgent to contact the Lindsay Department of Public Safety.
