### Seal Pups

"Parent & Me". Opportunity for parent and child to play together in the water. No real instruction provided.



### Sea Turtle

(Ages 3 - 5) Introductory to water. Increased emphasis on applicable water skills. Acquaint them with the pool and give them confidence in their own ability in the water. This class is not designed to teach children to become accomplished swimmers nor should it be considered a "drown-proofing" program.



### Seahorse

(Ages 4 & up): Introductory swimming skills; children with no previous experience in the water who are ready to learn. During this class, children are taught the basic elements of swimming including holding breath, buoyancy and movement. This class is not designed to be considered a "drown-proofing" program.



### Dolphin

(Ages 5 & up): Beginning swimming skills re-enforced with an ultimate goal of a 15-yard unassisted crawl stroke swim.



### Stingray

(Ages 5 & up): (Open to students who successfully completed the Beginner course or able to swim a 15 yard crawl stroke with proper breathing technique) Focus on techniques of crawl stroke, introduction of elementary backstroke and underwater swimming.



### Swordfish

(6 & up): (Open to students who successfully completed the Advanced Beginner course) Intermediate course provides the student an opportunity to improve upon the individual swimming skills and endurance. Focus on new strokes such as breast-stroke and competitive backstroke.



### Shark

Work on distance & technique of all strokes, gain endurance treading water and learn side stroke. Pre-requisite: Successful completion of Intermediates.

## RULES OF OPERATION

### I. Registration

- A. All entries must be submitted with a copy of their Mobile Vendor Permit and a photo of the mobile vehicle.
- B. All entries must be submitted 5 business days prior to the event.
- C. All food truck vendors will pay \$100 or 10% of their **nightly gross sales**, with a minimum payment of \$50.00. If a vendor earns less than \$500.00, they must still pay the minimum payment of \$50.00. All fees should be delivered to event organizer no later than 10:00 p.m. on the night event of event. The monies should be placed in a sealed envelope – no coins, please.
- D. Vendor must provide a photo of food truck with application.
- E. Application must be filled out completely.
- F. Once your application has been accepted, there will be **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS.**

### II. Food Trucks

- A. We will be allowing a maximum of vendors with the same type of food menu.
- B. Fee covers a maximum of 15 x 30 space size. This is to **include all leads, poles, and guy wires**, as well as your food truck. If more space is needed, be sure to note this on your application form and we will try to accommodate you.
- C. All vendors are responsible for their food truck set-up: 1) vendor set-up will be from 2:30 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. 2) all vendors **MUST CHECK IN** with a city employee before set-up. 3) **NO** vendors are to cease operation before the closing time of 9:00 p.m.
  - Food Trucks must supply their own trash cans, trash bags, **FIRE EXTINGUISHERS**, and **be responsible for the area to be clean at all times.**
- D. Operator must provide starting change for own booth.
- E. No TVs, radios, or amplified music will be allowed in food trucks without approval.
- F. If electricity is needed, vendor **MUST** provide their own generator.

### III. Vehicles

- A. Vehicles (personal) must be removed from the grounds 5:00 p.m. Parking is available on side streets and Wellness Center parking lot.

### IV. Liability

- A. Vendors shall maintain, at their sole expense, fire, liability, and property damage insurance.
- B. Vendors shall indemnify, defend and hold the City, its officers, employees and agents blameless from all loss, damage, or injury to any person or property taking part in the Food Truck events.



## **V. Mobile Vendor Permit**

A City of Lindsay Mobile Vendor Permit must be obtained by any person or organization that operates a food truck within City limits to provide food at community events. Vendors must apply for a Mobile Vendor Permit through the City of Lindsay City Services Department at 150 N Mirage Ave, Lindsay, CA 93247 or may contact directly at 559-562-5945 with any questions.

### MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Membership packages sold between 1/1/2023 and 7/13/23, which shows that we have sold a total of 156 membership packages in the last seven months, which is outstanding. This includes 58 month-to-month memberships (no contract), 12 paid-in-full memberships, 41 recurring (1 year contract), 36 Silver Sneakers, and 6 Renew Active.

Our growth is visibly noticeable in the amount of people using the facility during peak hours as compared to one year ago, and drastically from 2 years ago, and even pre-COVID. We have not only regained the memberships lost during the pandemic, but we have also surpassed them and are currently sitting at the highest membership count we have ever had since opening.

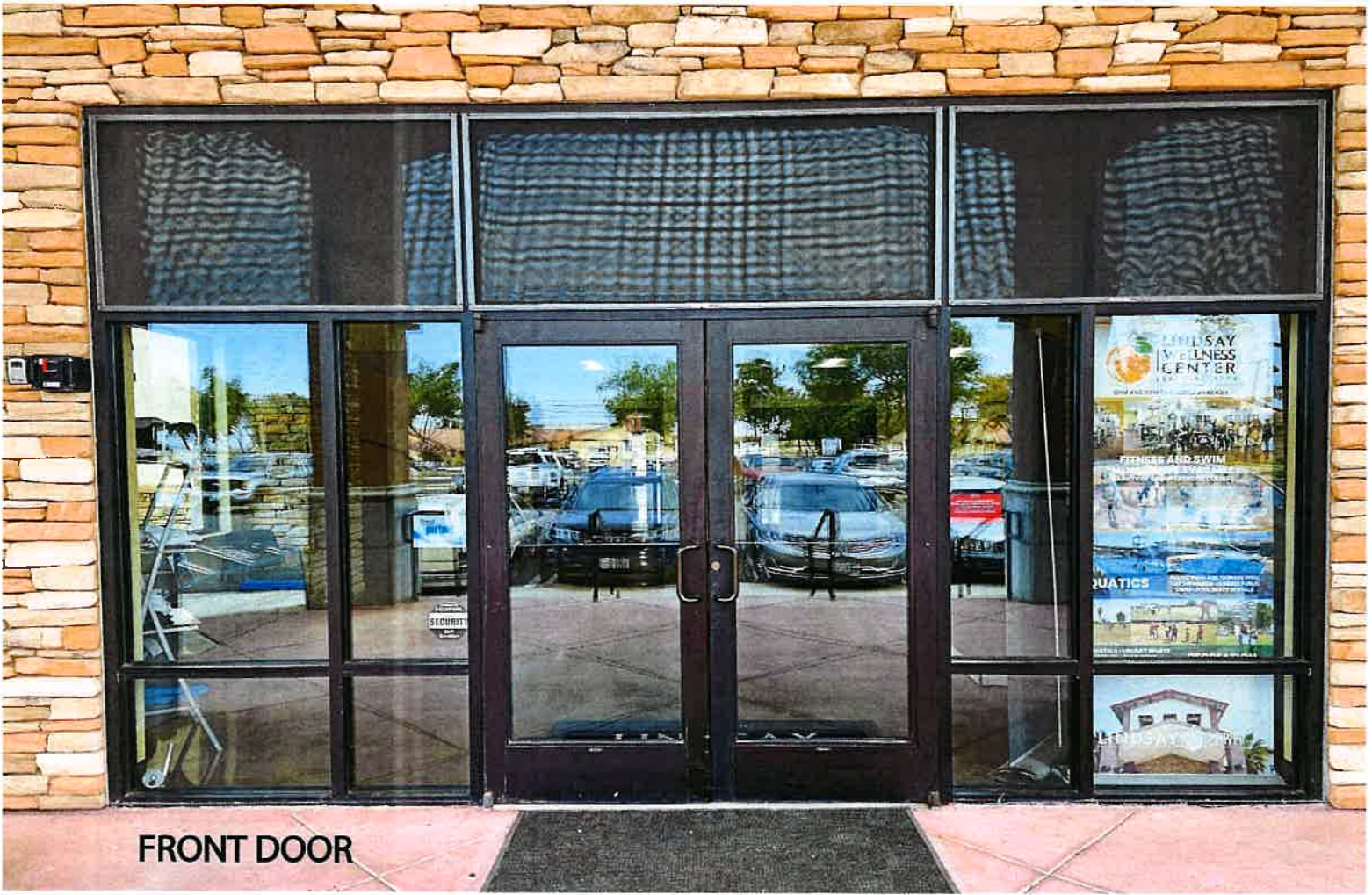
